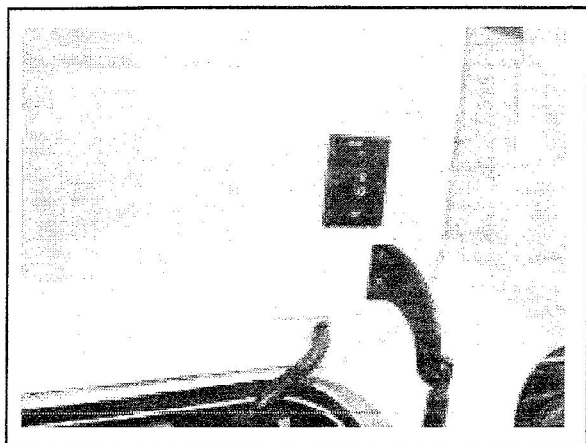

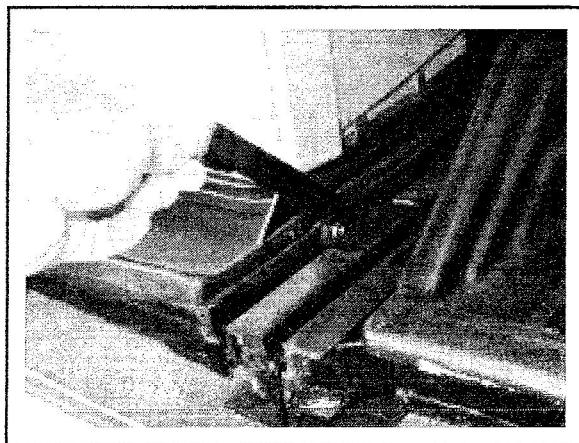

## Exterior Trunk/Sliding Tray Storage

The exterior trunk and sliding trays (power and non-power) allow convenient access to the storage bins. The power tray switch is located inside the trunk door. Before sliding out the non-powered trays, raise the locking latch as shown below. The latch will set automatically when the trays are retracted.
